

1:1 Support Sessions

Frequently Asked Questions

How long is a 1:1 Support Session?

1:1 Support Sessions can be up to 45minutes long.

Is a 1:1 Support Session the same as a lesson?

The 1:1 Support Session is not a lesson. In the session the teacher will look a piece of your own work and help you identify strengths and areas for improvement.

Will the teacher proofread my work?

A 1:1 Support Sessions is not a proof reading service. The session is to help you develop your English not to correct your work.

What happens in a 1:1 Support Session?

In a 1:1 Support Session, the teacher will look at a piece of your writing OR watch you give a presentation you are working on. They will then give you feedback on aspects of your English and advise you on what you can do to improve.

Do I need to prepare anything for my 1:1 Support Session?

Yes. You need to bring either a part of a written assignment (500 words max) or a presentation (10minutes max) you have been working on.

Can the teacher help me with an essay?

Teachers can only advise on pieces of writing that are less than 500 words. This means, they can look at part of an essay, but not the whole essay.

What happens if I have not prepared anything?

The session will not be able to go ahead and you will need to book another session.

What do I do if I cannot book any of the 1:1 Support Sessions?
